INTRODUCTORY RITE

Entrance Antiphon

PENITENTIAL RITE

The priest greets us and we respond:
✠ And with Your Spirit

Penitential Act

I confess to almighty God,
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have greatly sinned,
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done and in what I have
failed to do,

(strike our breast as we say:)

through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault;
therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin,
all the Angels and Saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord our God.

or

Have mercy on us, O Lord.
✠ For we have sinned against you.
Show us, O Lord, your mercy.
✠ And grant us your salvation.

or

Lord, have mercy. ✠ Lord, have mercy.
Christ, have mercy. ✠ Christ, have mercy.
Lord, have mercy. ✠ Lord, have mercy.

Or

Kyrie, eleison ✠ Kyrie, eleison.
Christe, eleison. ✠ Christe, eleison.
Kyrie, eleison. ✠ Kyrie, eleison.

After the absolution, we respond with
✠ Amen

The Gloria

Glory to God in the highest
and on earth peace to people of good will.
We praise you,
we bless you,
we adore you,
we glorify you,
we give you thanks for your great glory,
Lord God, heavenly King,
O God, almighty Father.
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,
Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,
you take away the sins of the world, have
mercy on us;
you take away the sins of the world,
receive our prayer;
you are seated at the right hand of the
Father, have mercy on us.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone
are the Lord, you alone are the Most High,
Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the
glory of God the Father. Amen.

First Reading, Psalm, Second Reading, Gospel Acclamation & Gospel

The Profession of Faith

I believe in one God,
the Father almighty,
maker of heaven and earth,
of all things visible and invisible.
I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ,
the Only Begotten Son of God,
born of the Father, before all ages.
God from God, Light from Light,
true God from true God,
begotten, not made, consubstantial with the
Father;

through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation
he came down from heaven,

Bow our heads for the next three lines

and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the
Virgin Mary,
and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius
Pilate,

he suffered death and was buried,

and rose again on the third day

in accordance with the Scriptures.

He ascended into heaven

and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory

to judge the living and the dead

and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the
giver of life,

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,

who with the Father and the Son is adored

and glorified,

who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic
Church.

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of
sins

and I look forward to the resurrection of the
dead

and the life of the world to come.

The Eucharistic Prayer

The Lord be with you.

The Mystery of Faith

There are three possible acclamations:
We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and
profess your Resurrection until you
come again.

or

When we eat this Bread and drink this
Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord,
until you come again.

or

Save us, Saviour of the world, for by
your Cross and Resurrection, you have
set us free.

THE COMMUNION RITE

The sign of Peace

The peace of the Lord be with you always.

✠ And with your spirit.

The Agnus Dei *(unchanged)*

Lamb of God, you take away the sins of
the world, have mercy on us.

Invitation to Communion

Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who
takes away the sins of the world.

Blessed are those called to the supper of
the Lamb.

✠ Lord, I am not worthy that you should

word and my soul shall be healed.

The Final Blessing

The Lord be with you.

✠ And with your spirit.
